Community consultation for Dripstone Playground

Darwin City Council is asking the community to have their say on the building of a proposed playground near Dripstone Cliffs.

Council is proposing to build a Richardson Ward Regional Playground in the picnic area of the Dripstone Cliffs. This area is part of the Casuarina Coastal Reserve and would be leased from NT Parks and Wildlife.

Darwin City Council Lord Mayor Graeme Sawyer said the playground was intended to serve families living in Richardson Ward, as well as the broader Darwin area.

“Council would like to create a safe, welcoming regional playground similar to the one at Lake Alexander, East Point,” he said.

“I really encourage residents to have their say on this proposal and take the opportunity to be involved in the consultation.

Darwin City Council has engaged consultants to consult the community on this proposal. To have your say either:

- Visit the Darwin City Council website, where there is more information on the proposal and complete the online survey, or
- Come and talk to the consultants at the site of the proposed playground, to the right of the Dripstone Cliffs carpark between 3pm and 6 pm on Sunday, 27 November 2011.
